
### How to access your LinkIt! Data



#### General guidance:

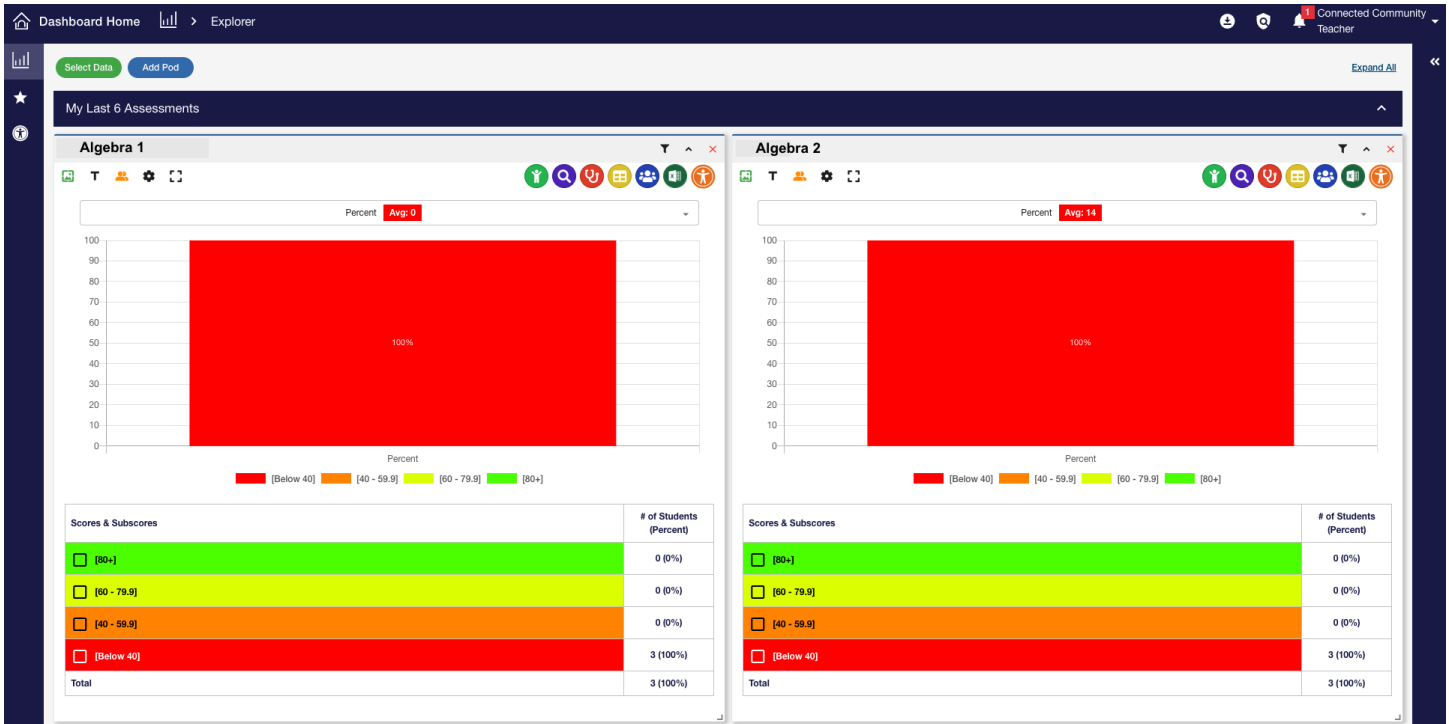
1. Access the LinkIt Platform.
  - a. Go to <https://proxlearnnational.linkit.com/Account/LogOn>
  - b. Click the Sign in with Google button
  - c. Sign in using your @proxlearn.com email





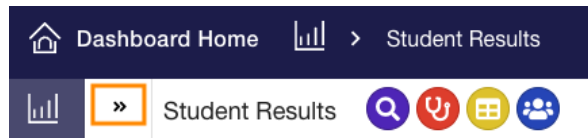
2. Once logged in, click on Reporting >> Dashboard in the left navigation menu. This will open a new tab.



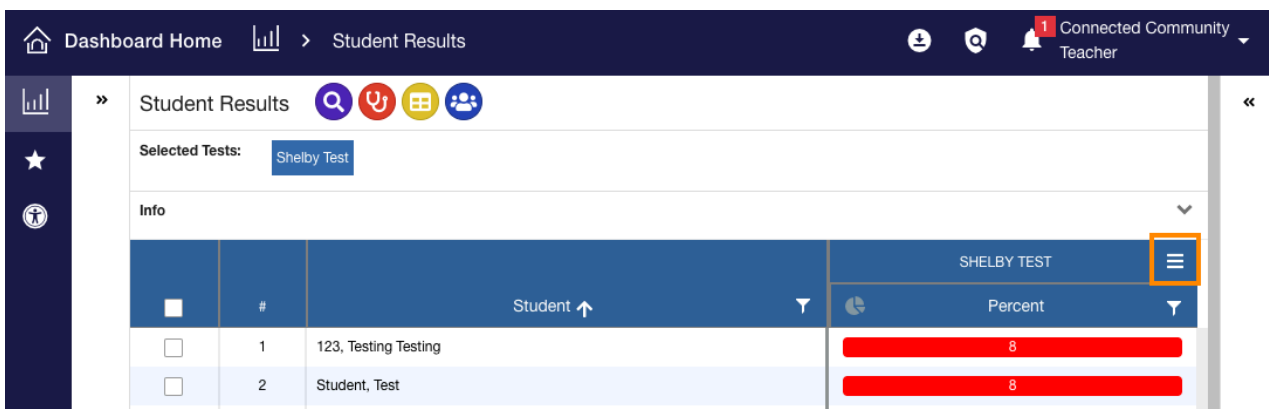
### 3. From here, you will see each test that has been given.





- a. Click on the green icon with the person  to see Student Results for a particular test.
  - i. This will open a new tab
  - ii. The report will list all students with a score.
    1. If all of your classes in that subject area appear, click on the  icon in the top left to open up the data filter panel (see below). [Click here](#) to learn more about how to use the data filter panel.

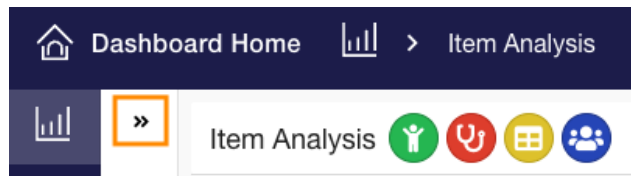


- iii. Scores are shown as a percent score. You can also opt to view the raw score by clicking on the three line menu and selecting raw (see below).




b. Click on the purple magnifying glass  to see Item Analysis for a particular test.

- i. This will open in a new tab.
- ii. This will allow you to see a summary of performance by item.

iii. You can also select the option to see student answer selections (see below).

c. Click on the red stethoscope  to see Class Diagnostics.

- i. This will open in a new tab.
- ii. Use the dropdown menu to select a particular class.
- iii. In the "Show only standards with 3 or more associated items" adjust the number down to 1.
- iv. View how each class performed on a given standard as well as individual student performance (student results appear when you print the results or save them as a PDF).
